

GRE (Graduate Record Examination):

Required for Master's degree in Non-Management courses in USA.

Format: Computer Based Test (CBT)

Score Valid for 5 years.

Sections:

a) Analytical Writing (AW): 30 minutes per Section
Section 1: Analyze an Issue Section 2: Analyze an Argument

 b) Verbal Reasoning: Sections 3 & 4: 20-25 Q/30 minutes / Section 8-10 Q Reading Comprehension, 7-10 Q Text Completion & 5 Q Sentence Equivalence.

c) Quantitative Reasoning: Sections 5 & 6:20-25 Q/35 minutes / Section Problem solving (Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry) Quantitative Comparison Questions, Numeric Entry Questions, Data Analysis & Data Interpretation Questions

GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test)

Required for Master's degree in Management courses in USA.

Format: Computer Based Test (CBT)

Score Valid for 5 years.

1. Analytical Writing Assessment: 30 minutes

2. Quantitative Section: Problem Solving, Data Sufficiency. 37 Q/75 minutes

3. Verbal Section: Sentence Correction, Critical Reasoning, Reading Comprehension. 41 Q / 75 minutes

4. Integrated Reasoning Section: Table Analysis, Graphics Interpretation, Multi-Source, Two-Part Analysis. 12Q/30 minutes

SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test):

Required for Undergraduate courses in USA.

Format: Computer Based Test (CBT)

Score Valid for 5 years.

 Evidence-Based Reading and Writing Reading Test (52 Q/65 minutes)
 Writing and Language Test (44 Q/35 minutes)

2. Math (58 Q/80 minutes)

3. Essay (optional) (1 essay/ 50 minutes)

Maximum Score: 1600 (800 each for English and Maths), 8 for Essay



TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)

Required for admission in USA and other countries.

Format: Internet based test (IBT)

Score Valid for 2 yrs.

Listening - 6 to 9 passages in 60 to 90 minutes
Reading - 3 to 5 passages in 60 to 100 minutes

Essay Writing - 2 tasks in 60 minutes
Speaking - 6 tasks in 20 minutes

Maximum Score: 120 marks

IELTS

IELTS (International English Language Testing System)

Required for admission in UK, Australia, Canada and other countries.

Format: Paper based test (PBT)

Score Valid for 2 yrs.

Sections:

Listening - 4 sections of 6 minutes each

Total 40 to 42 questions in 40 minutes

Reading - 3 passages of 20 minutes

Total 40 to 42 questions in 60 minutes

Writing - Task 1 (20 minutes) - Report Writing: 150 words

Task 2 (40 minutes) - Essay Writing: 250 words

Speaking - 3 parts - Total 15 minutes

2-3 minutes: Self Introduction

2-3 minutes : Speaking on a Topic Given

3-4 minutes : Questions on the Topic Spoken
