

- 4. Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee. The functions of Antii-Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, grounds, Hostels etc. The Squad will also educate the students ai large by adopting various means about the menace of Ragging and related Punishments there to. A gamut of positive reinforcement activities are adopted by Anti-Ragging Squad for orienting students and moldings their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging committee.
- 5. To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.
- 6. To submit enquiry report along with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action taken.
- 7. Consider the complaints received from the student and conduct enquiry and submit the report to the director.

Objectives of Anti-Ragging Committee

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of dated 16-05-2007 and Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009 ,dated 08-05-2009 and with reference to AICTE ,the institute has framed following objectives for creating ragging free atmosphere in and outside the campus:

- 1. To uphold and comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme court and be vigilant on nay acts amounting to ragging.
- To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there of in any fresher or any other student.
- 4. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- 5. With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
- 6. To root out Ragging in all its forms from the institution by prohibiting it by law preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of the Regulations and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force
